
Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the "Nicholson Drive Water Transmission Line Project" in Fiscal Year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Hudson, OH, whose offices are located at 1140 Terex Road, Hudson, OH 44236. The location of this project is Nicholson Drive, Hudson, Ohio 44236, between State Route 303 and Barlow Road. The City of Hudson would use this funding to connect two major transmission mains within the City water system, and is a good use of taxpayer funding because it will improve the quality of residents' drinking water, provide increased fire protection, and connect nearby residents currently without access to the City's water system.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
