Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting \$2,000,000 in funding for the 7th Streetscape & Bus Lane project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of North Canton located at 145 N. Main, North Canton, Ohio 44720. The funding would be used to support a streetscape and roadway expansion project along 7th Street NE, adjacent to the North Canton City Schools campus located at 525 7th Street NE.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these improvements will help ensure that the roadway can safely and efficiently accommodate the increased transportation demands created by the new school campus while improving the overall function and appearance of a key corridor in the community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 23 USC 133 (Surface Transportation Block Grant Program).
